Medications

Sedative Infusions

propofol (DIPRIVAN) 10 mg/mL

- 5 microgram/kilogram per minute continuous intravenous infusion May titrate to max 80 microgram/kilogram per minute to achieve appropriate sedation level; DC prior to extubation

dexmedetomidine (PRECEDEX) in NS 400 mcg/100 ml (4 mcg/ml)

- 0.5 microgram/kilogram per hour continuous intravenous infusion ; May titrate to 1.5 microgram/kilogram per hour to achieve appropriate sedation level

Vasoactive Infusions

diltiazem (CARDIZEM) 125 mg in 125 mL

- 5 milligram/hour continuous intravenous infusion titrate to keep HR < 140 (MAX 15 milligram/hour)

DOBUTamine (DOBUTREX) [500 milligrams/ 250 milliliters D5W]

- 2.5 microgram/kilogram per minute continuous intravenous infusion : titrate to keep SBP > 90 mmHg with a mean arterial pressure greater than or equal to 65 mmHg and Heart Rate < 140 beats per minute (MAX 10 microgram/kilogram per minute)

DOPamine in D5W 400 mg/250 mL (1,600 mcg/mL) IV

- 5 microgram/kilogram per minute continuous intravenous infusion: titrate to keep SPB greater than or equal to 90mmHg and MAP greater than or equal to 65 mmHg (MAX 20 microgram/kilogram per minute)

EPINEPHrine in Dextrose 5% water (0.016 milligram/milliliter)

- 0.5 microgram/kilogram per minute continuous intravenous infusion (dose range 0.1-1 microgram/kilogram per minute) Titrate to keep systolic blood pressure greater than 90 mmHg

niCARDipine (CARDENE) 20 mg in 200 mL

- 5 milligram/hour continuous intravenous infusion titrate to keep SBP > 90 mmHg and MAP greater than or equal to 65 mmHg (MAX 15 milligram/hour)

norepinephrine bitartrate in normal saline 4 mg/250 mL IV (LEVOPHED)

- 1 microgram/minute continuous intravenous infusion: titrate to keep SBP greater than 90 mmHg and MAP greater than or equal to 65 mmHg (MAX 30 microgram/minute)

phenylephrine in NS (preserv free) 20 mg/250 mL (80 mcg/mL) IV (NEO-SYNEPHRINE)

- 20 microgram/minute continuous intravenous infusion titrate to keep SBP greater than 90 mmHg and MAP greater than or equal to 65 mmHg (MAX 180 microgram/minute)

vasopressin (PITRESSIN)[40 unit/100 milliliter NS]

- 0.03 unit/minute continuous intravenous infusion titrate to keep MAP greater than 80 mmHg (MAX 0.04 unit/minute)
